**'DONKEY - HOTEY' TAKES UP RESIDENCE AT WNDC**

On June 14, 2006, the Woman's National Democratic Club will become the new home for the one of the famous party animals that recently decorated Washington's streets. In a ceremony on Flag Day, June 14, 'Donkey-Hotey', will be dedicated and stand as a reminder that Democrats are united in their push for a Democratic Congress in November.
