Wayne R. Through her verdicts and settlements, Ms. Brooks-Rodney has obtained millions of dollars for her injured clients and has worked on a plethora of high profile cases. Most recently, Ms. Brooks-Rodney was retained to represent the families of victims killed in the June 2009 Metro crash in Washington, D.C. Prior to working on the side of the injured victim, Ms. Brooks-Rodney was a defense lawyer serving as the Managing Attorney of Hartford Insurance Company's Staff Counsel Office in Alexandria, Virginia.
